CENTRALISED VALIDATION OF ASSESSMENT

In Maharishi Vidya Mandir Secondary School, Thiruvarur teachers are evaluating the students' assessment paper as centralised validation Guideline. Usually these kind of practices happen only during Board Examinations. But in our school, teachers are doing this kind of validation right from Grade 1 to 9. Each child's individual result is analysed and section wise comments are given by the teachers. This is to bring to notice that they are committed as Thiruvarur Maharishians.



NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT SURVEY (NAS)

The National Achievement Survey is aimed to conduct a survey on sample to assess the learning achievement of children every three years. The recent pandemic had forced the closure of schools and interrupted learning at different levels.

Hence there is an urgent need to evaluate their progress and learning competencies to analyse and examine the health of the education sector in order to take necessary action at the district, state and national level. It is essential to gauge the education system before and after lockdown to evaluate the impact of school closures on the students' learning.

In view of this, NAS is now being conducted on 12th November 2021.

NAS 2021 will cover the entire spectrum of schools i.e., Government Schools Under Central and State Government, Government Aided schools and

Private schools. Approximately 1.24 lakh schools and 39 lakh students in 733 districts across 36 States/UTs will be covered. It will assess the grade specific competencies achieved by students of Grades 3, 5, 8 and 10 in sampled schools. NAS is being administered by CBSE in collaboration with the respective state educational departments who have nominated State Nodal Officers, District Nodal Officer and Field Investigators, for smooth survey.

Besides, one of the most important features of this survey (NAS 2021) is that it must be conducted in a fair and transparent manner for obtaining results of high accuracy. Also, the findings of the NAS will have national significance and hence its creditability remains a crucial aspect at all stages of NAS administration. In this regard, CBSE portal sends the notification and details. Our school Principal, PRTs, TGTs had registered for this and have been appointed as an observer in NAS.
